In "gym" which we spell g-y-m, "m" and "y" are used to tell you how our arms move.



The letters in the word "gym" which we spell g-y-m mean: g - up high, y - from a "y" shape, m - to an "m" shape. Or, "gym", which we spell g-y-m tells us how to climb up on the bar.

"Swim" is another word that uses "w" and "m" the same way "gym" uses "y" and "m", so you can figure "swim" out with a friend or by yourself, if you like.
