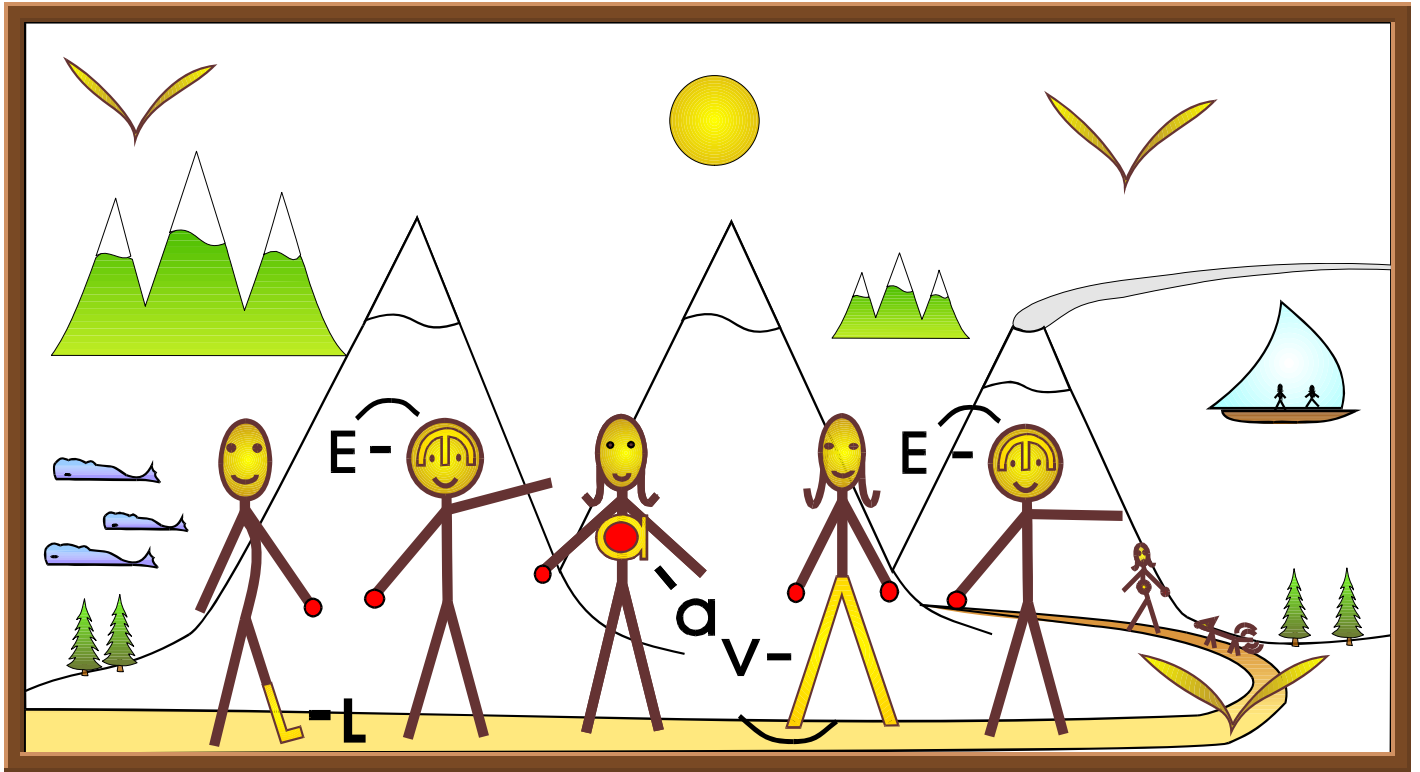


Leave means: l [the leg or legs] - with the legs, e [the eyes] - see, a (ah) [the heart] - as I breathe, v [the dividing legs] - and divide my legs as I walk, e [the eyes] - see. Or, to leave.



"Move" and "leave" in English, "voyage" and "au revoir" in French, "vamos" and "vaya" in Spanish and "arrivederci" and "via" in Italian all use "v" in a similar way.

Inconsistent pronunciation of some symbols (like in the Spanish and English alphabets) has caused humans to have languages that are not easily understood by speakers of another similar language, even though the languages use many of the same symbols and the same natural pure sounds.
